Re: Title V Fees for Calendar Year 2011 are due by March 1, 2012.

Dear Air Permittee:

There have been several changes in the Title V emission fee requirements in recent years. First, the Department is no longer required to send fee payment notices by mail. Second, beginning with the calendar year 2008 fees, **the Title V annual emissions fee factor was raised to \$30 per ton** of each regulated pollutant allowed to be emitted. In addition, pursuant to Rule 62-4.090, F.A.C., the application submission deadline for Title V permit renewals for a permit that expires on or after June 1, 2009 has been changed to 225 days before the expiration of the existing permit.

As a reminder, Title V fees for calendar year 2011 are due and payable between January 15 and March 1, 2012. Any fees that are due, but not postmarked by March 1, 2012, will incur a penalty of 50% of the amount of the unpaid fee plus interest on such amount computed in accordance with section 220.807, Florida Statutes (except as provided at Rule 62-213.205, F.A.C.) in addition to the unpaid fee. The Department may revoke any Title V air operation permit for failure to timely pay any required annual emissions fee, penalty or interest.

If you believe that your facility obtained non-Title V status prior to January 1, 2011, please provide documentation of the permitting action that established the non-Title V status. If the Department determines that a non-Title V status was established prior to January 1, 2011, no Title V fee is due for calendar year 2011. If a non-Title V status was established during 2011, then the fees will be pro-rated for the time of operation as a Title V facility.
