Rulemaking Notices - Prior to 12/28/01, all Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) rulemaking notices were published in the Florida Administrative Weekly (FAW). Between 12/28/01 and 6/30/06, all DEP rule development notices were published on DEP’s “Official Notices” website rather than in the FAW. These notices may be viewed at the “Official Notices” link on the DEP website at www.dep.state.fl.us. (Click on “Index by Subject,” then “Official Notices.”). Clean Air Act Plan Revision Notices - Prior to 12/18/09, all notices of proposed State Implementation Plan (SIP) revisions and Section 111(d) State Plans were published both in the FAW (or on DEP “Official Notices” website) and in one or more newspapers across the state. If different newspapers published the notice on different dates, the date of publication is listed in this report as “on or before” the latest date published. Beginning 12/18/09, all SIP and 111(d) State Plan notices were published in the FAW only.

SIP Numbering – In 1998, DEP began numbering its proposed SIP revisions according to the year and order of submission to EPA; e.g., 1998-01, 1998-02, etc. Prior SIP submittals have been retroactively assigned numbers according to this system and given new cover pages reflecting such. EPA uses a different numbering system, but DEP and EPA records align with one another on the date of submittal.
