This is a generic model; it requires customizing to fit your local needs. There is a four-step process, outlined in the Panic File, for putting your custom version together. It entails looking over the “what-ifs” at your facility, organizing in a fashion similar to this generic model, then training the staff on what to do as well as who to contact for each situation. Most of the common problems that occur in a marina or boatyard will be found in the model Panic File. The last step is to review the finished product at least once each year to assure accuracy of phone numbers, names, and procedures. A floppy disk (Word version) is included, which allows the customized version to be prepared, printed, and easily updated.
