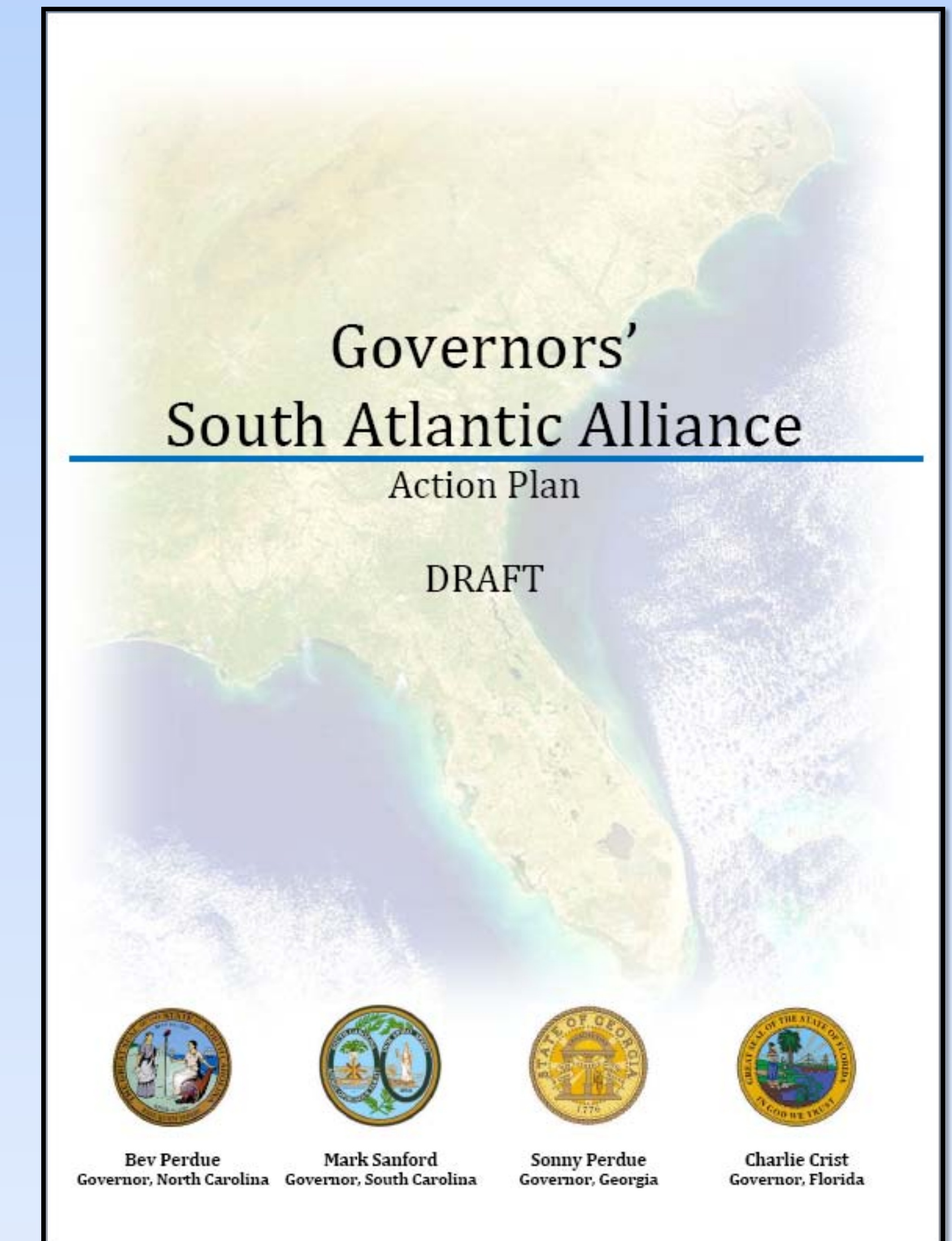
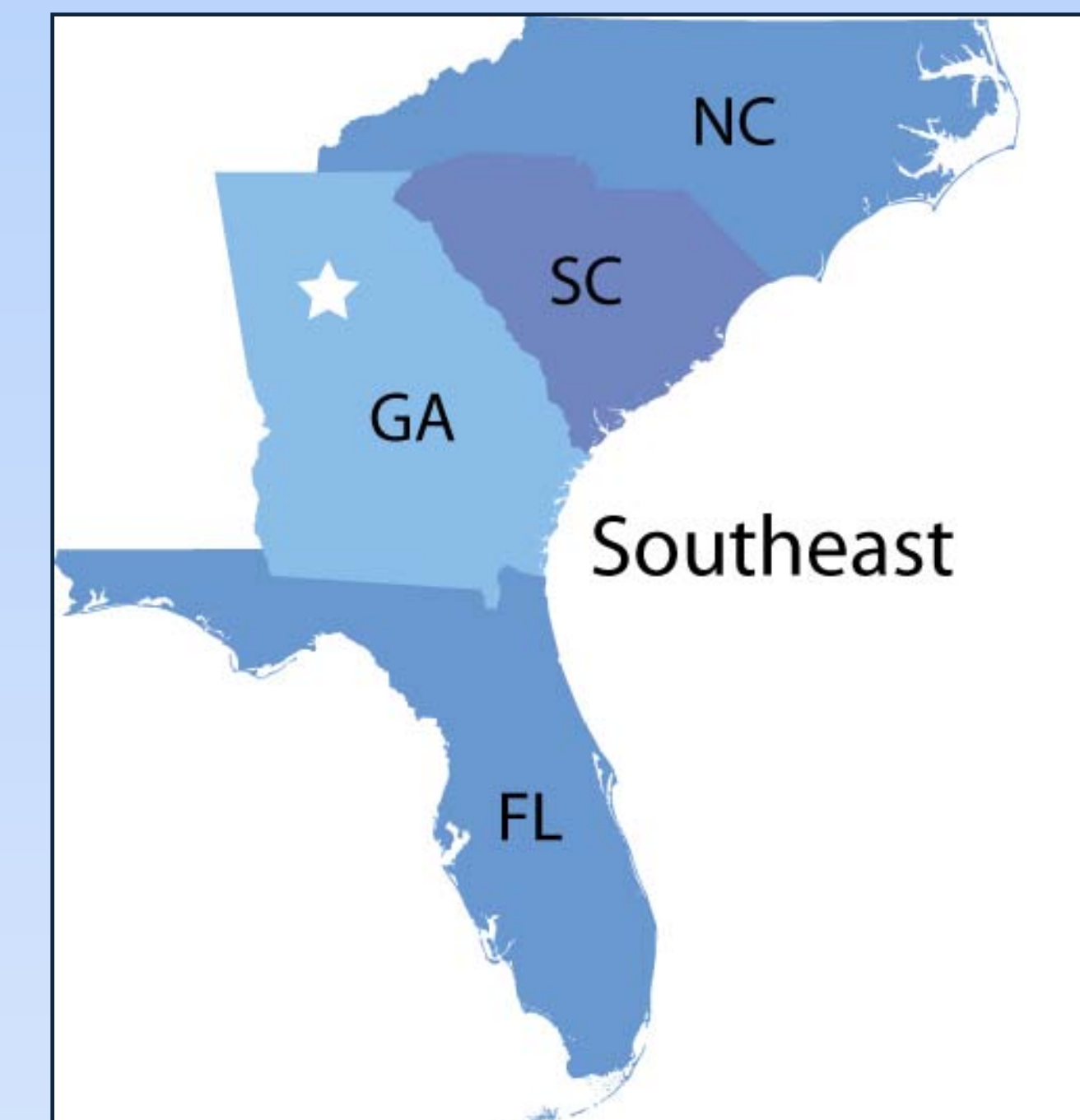

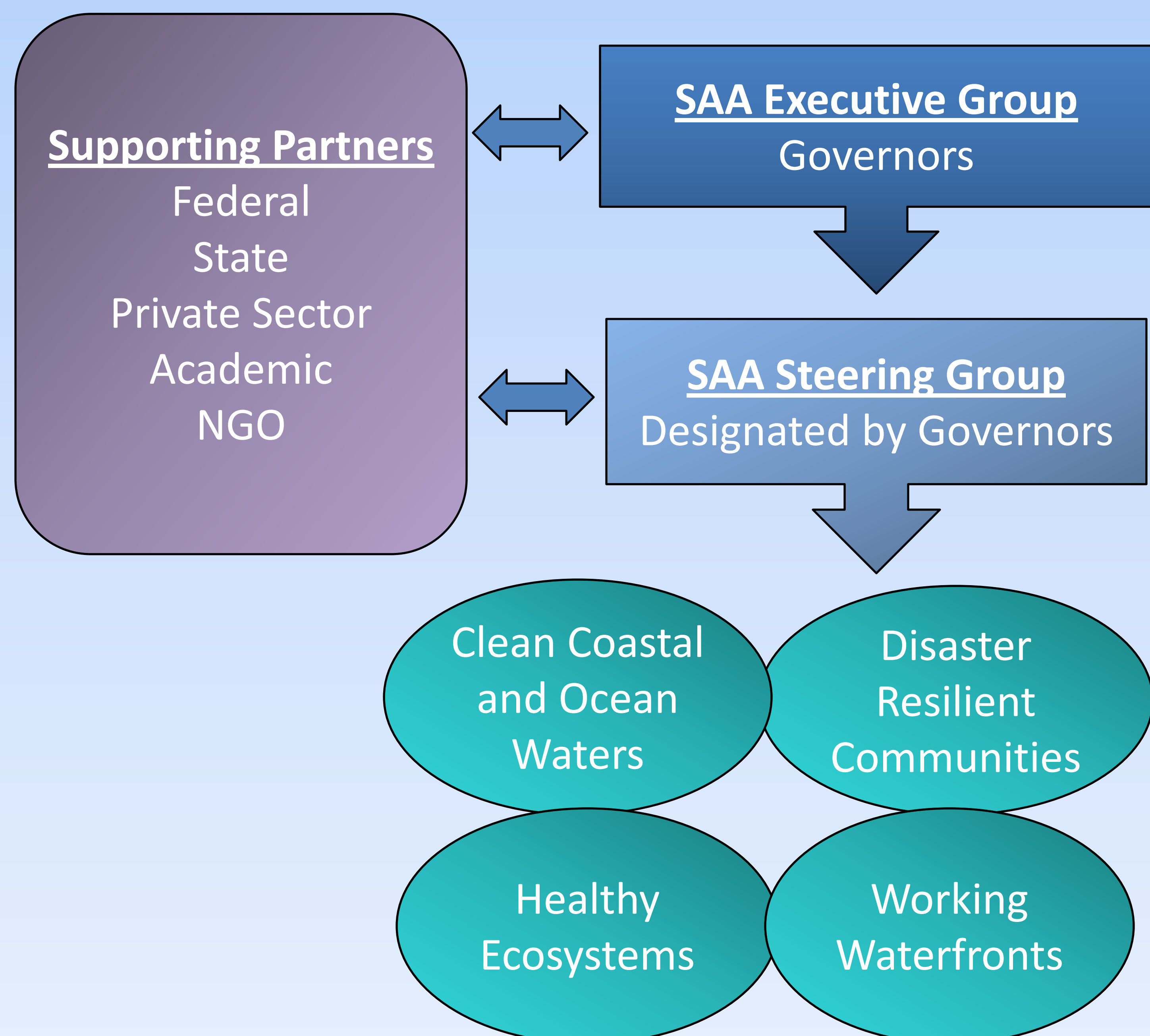
Draft Action Plan
