The Geospatial Assessment Tool for Operations and Response, or GATOR, is the flagship common operation picture/situational awareness application for the Florida Division of Emergency Management and the State Emergency Response Team. GATOR is an interactive web mapping tool for the display of geographic information to support emergency preparedness, operations, and response. Real-time data like weather radar, weather watches and warnings, and tropical storm tracks are displayed along with base map data like roads, facilities, and aerial photographs.

GATOR is an Adobe Flex Application that displays REST web mapping services and GeoRSS.

Hover over each of these icons in the viewer window to see a drop down menu of available functions.
