BROWSER GUIDE

Instructions are based on Internet Explorer version 9.0 Results may vary depending on your individual browser.

The contents tab will show all of the layers available in the web map. The layers can be checked on and off.

The basemap button will let you select and apply the basemap of your choice

Use the search to type in a city or address to find a specific location on the map

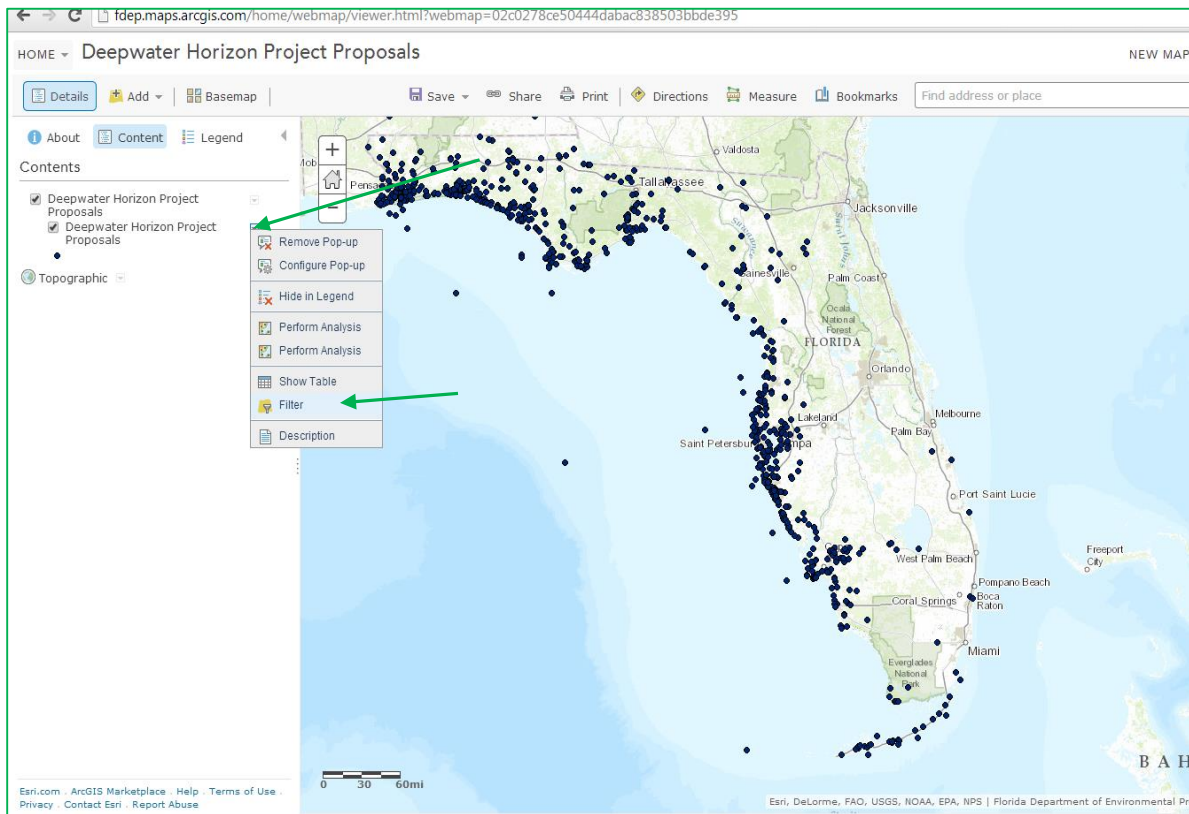
By Clicking on any point, a pop-up box will appear with the project specifics. One location may have multiple projects, click the arrow button to see the additional projects for each location. For more information to the public FTP site, click on the proposal hyperlink.

This tool bar allows users to zoom in and zoom out. By pressing the home icon, the map is returned to its full extent.

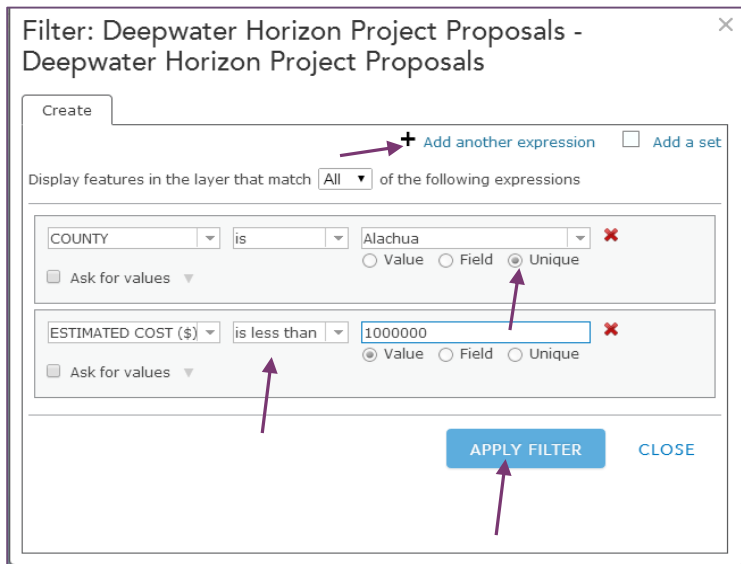

Filtering Points – Filtering allows unique sets of project points to be viewed based on set criteria



Click on the gray downward arrow to the right of the Deepwater Horizon Project Proposal point layer, and select **Filter** from the drop down list.



A filter dialog box will appear with different options to filter through the data. Select any category from the drop down list on the left. Depending on the selection, use the two boxes to the right to define the expression. By selecting the **unique** button on the right, a drop-down list will become available of fields to select from. Click the **+** button to add additional options to your filter. In this example, the expression is set to only show points which are in Alachua County and have an estimated cost which is less than \$1,000,000. Once the expressions are set for the filter, click **Apply Filter**. After the filter is applied, the points on the map will only reflect the ones which meet the criteria that was set in the expression.



To remove or edit a filter, first repeat the steps above with the green arrows and open the filter dialog box. To edit the filter, select the **Edit** tab and change the expression. To remove the filter, click **Remove Filter** and **Close**.
