Gulf Coast Incident Management Team/Florida Branch

- Gulf Coast Incident Management Team (GCIMT) remains active in New Orleans, LA with the consolidated MS/ AL/ FL Branch Office located in Gulf Shores, AL.
- Supporting the GCIMT is George Henderson (FWC), State On-Scene Coordinator (SOSC). George provided support remotely this week.
- Representatives from the U.S. Coast Guard (USCG), FDEP and BP are staffing the consolidated Branch Office.

Florida Activities

- One Shoreline Cleanup Assessment Technique (SCAT) team, that includes FDEP personnel, continues to conduct scientific assessments of the FL coast on a daily basis. The team documents oil found and provides cleanup recommendations.

Florida Activities continued

- Fort Morgan, AL was signed out of the response on June 10, 2013 officially ending the response in the Eastern States, MS, AL & FL. The CG and DEP wrote press releases on this announcement. DEP's press release can be viewed at <http://content.govdelivery.com/accounts/FLDEP/bulletins/7dacb8>
- BP released their July 4th Holiday Stand down plans. GCIMT will be stood down from 1200 July 3rd to 0700 July 8th. BP will have personnel on stand by to respond to any National Response Center (NRC) calls.
- Meeting with the National Park Service (NPS) is scheduled for June 19th to work out the final details of DEP conducting long term monitoring on NPS property, prior to the departure of the Park's Oil Spill Division.
- Thirty four NRC reports were filed between June 7th - 14th for oil in FL; all 34 were confirmed MC-252. The CG deployed OSRO teams on six reports.
