## Gulf Coast Incident Management Team/Florida Branch

- Gulf Coast Incident Management Team (GCIMT) remains active in New Orleans, LA with the consolidated MS/ AL/FL Branch Office located in Gulf Shores, AL.
- Supporting the GCIMT is George Henderson (FWC), State On-Scene Coordinator (SOSC). George provided support remotely this week.
- Representatives from the U.S. Coast Guard (USCG), FDEP and BP are staffing the consolidated Branch Office.

## Florida Activities continued

- This is the final DWH weekly response update. Starting in July the main activities occurring in FL will be DEP's Beach Monitoring Program and the National Response Center (NRC) weekly updates.
- Effective July 1<sup>st</sup>, DEP will stop staffing the consolidated Gulf Shores, AL Branch Office.
- Capt. Sparks replaced Capt. Walker as the GCIMT FOSC on June 28<sup>th</sup>. Capt. Walker will continue to do some GCIMT activities as he transitions to the Commander of Sector Mobile. The Eastern States paperwork will be signed by Capt. Walker.
- The final max oiling maps and Governors' packages are being put together for the three Eastern States, MS, AL and FL.
- Capt. Walker will meet with DEP Secretary Vinyard in Pensacola on July 10<sup>th</sup> for a final consultation.
- USFWS will host a Programmatic Consultation for the USCG Post-Deepwater Horizon Minimal Response on July 9<sup>th</sup>. The consultation will describe the Section 7 trust resource expectations for NRC calls. Representatives from USFWS, USCG, NPS and DEP will be attending.
- BP will conduct a final walk through inspection of access points used by the response in Bay, Walton and Escambia Counties on July 10<sup>th</sup>.

- Twenty three NRC reports were filed between June 20<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> for oil in FL; all were confirmed MC-252. The CG deployed OSRO teams for one report.
  - FLES1-018 & 019, GUIIS Perdido Key- Crews recovered 3.87 lb
