



# FLORIDA DEEPWATER HORIZON RESPONSE WEEKLY UPDATE

November 28, 2012

## Gulf Coast Incident Management Team/Florida Branch

- Gulf Coast Incident Management Team (GCIMT) remains active in New Orleans, LA with the Florida Branch Office located in Mary Esther, FL.
- Supporting the GCIMT is Darryl Boudreau (FDEP), State On-Scene Coordinator (SOSC), and George Henderson (FWC), State Scientific Support Coordinator (SSC). Darryl and George both provided remote support this week.
- Representatives from the U.S. Coast Guard (USCG), FDEP and BP are staffing the Florida Branch Office.
- The Florida Branch, is supervising the activities of two Divisions, staffed by BP and their contract personnel with USCG oversight:
  - Division 1 - Western Escambia County (Perdido Key)
  - Division 2 - Eastern Escambia (Pensacola Beach), Santa Rosa, Okaloosa and Walton Counties.

## Florida Activities

- One Shoreline Cleanup Assessment Technique (SCAT) team, that includes FDEP personnel, continues to conduct scientific assessments of the FL coast on a daily basis. The Team documents oil found and provides cleanup recommendations.
- Product continues to be collected, documented and weighed by segment on a daily basis.

### **Florida Activities continued**

- The National Park Service gave the Branch approval to recover the subsurface oil delineated by SCAT in segment FLES1-035 (GUIS- Ft. Pickens). Recovery efforts will be by manual removal only to a maximum depth of 24 inches unless approval is given to go deeper. Between 11.26 and 11.28 Operations removed 107 lbs of material.
- The Christmas Holiday schedules for the GCIMT and the FL Branch office were distributed.
  - Both offices will be closed from 1700 Dec. 21, 2012 to 0700 Jan. 3, 2013. All operations, including beach cleaning, will be stood down during this time.
