Dear Governor Scott, President Haridopolos, and Speaker Cannon:

Senate Bill 1516 (2010), Section 5, created Section 216.0153, F.S., requiring the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to submit to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives a list of state owned property recommended for disposition by October 1 of each year. No report was made in 2010 because of the Governor's veto of the bill. We elected to provide this interim report regarding surplus real property following the Legislature's November 16, 2010 override of the veto. Subsequent reports will be provided each October 1.

This interim report lists state owned property with potential for disposition, including vacant land compiled by DEP and land with facilities compiled by the Department of Management Services. Lists of properties sold and properties placed under management leases since July 1, 2009, are also included.
