DESIGNATION OF MINOR VIOLATIONS OF RULES

Rule	Requirement
62-531.380(2)	Failure to display a contractor license number on both sides of each piece of drilling equipment owned, leased, or operated by the contractor.
62-531.420(2)	Failure to submit a permit application in writing within 10 days after an emergency permit application is granted.
62-532.400(2)(b)	Failure to supply additional information as requested.
62-532.400(5)	Failure to apply for an amended permit prior to changing well location.
62-532.400(4)	Failure to make the permit available for inspection at the site during construction, repair, or abandonment of a well.
62-532.400(6)	Failure to request an extension prior to expiration of a permit in the event construction, repair, or abandonment is not complete.
62-532.410	Failure to submit a completion report within 30 days after well completion.
62-532.400(1)	Failure to use the appropriate completion report form.
62-532.400(1)	Failure to file an accurate completion report.
