Rain: There will be a slight chance of an isolated afternoon sea breeze thunderstorm this afternoon across the western panhandle and southern Florida. Dry air will preclude any widespread activity. **Lightning:** An occasional lightning strike is possible. **Wind:** Light to near calm winds overnight along with the high humidity will also help improve fire containment. However, as winds decrease and humidity increases this evening and tonight, thick smoke and ash will be able to stay very close to the ground.
