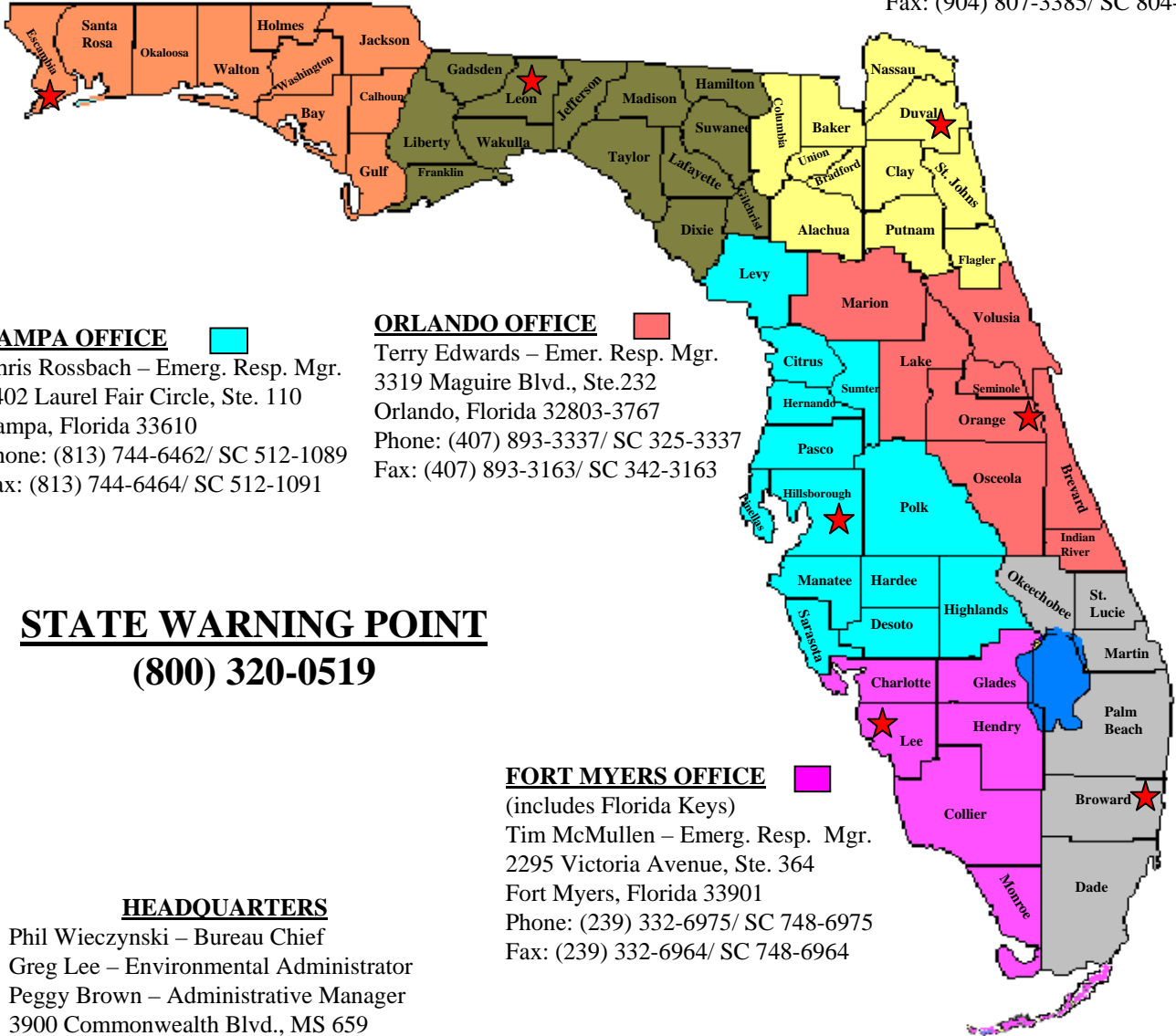

Useful Information When Reporting a Spill

- ✓ Name, address and telephone number of reporting person.
- ✓ Name, address and telephone number of person responsible for the discharge or release.
- ✓ Date and time of the discharge or released material.
- ✓ Type or name of discharged or released material.
- ✓ Estimated amount of the discharge or release.
- ✓ Location or address of the discharge or release.
- ✓ Source and cause of the discharge or release.
- ✓ Size and characteristics of area affected by the discharge or release.
- ✓ Containment and cleanup actions taken to date.
- ✓ Other persons or agencies contacted.
