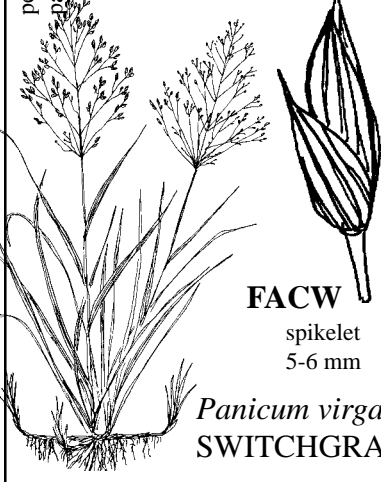
Cladium jamaicense SAW-GRASS

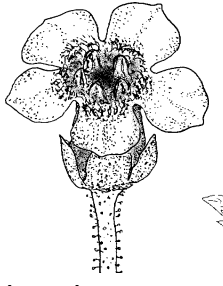

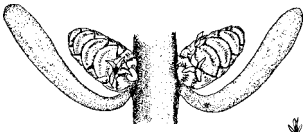

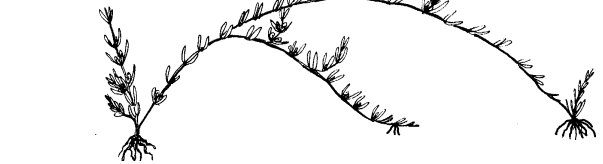

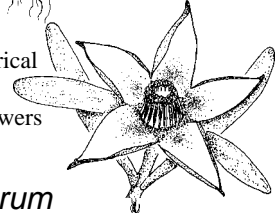

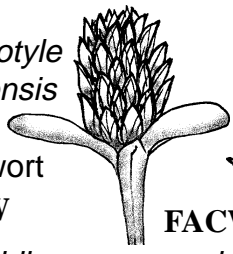
