



Introducing the new 8700-12FL Florida Notification of Regulated Waste Activity Form

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection is notifying you of an updated version of the 8700-12FL Florida Notification of Regulated Waste Activity form (effective date of January 4, 2009). The new 8700-12FL form has been redesigned to include mercury and used oil program area registrations in addition to hazardous and universal waste generator activities. The new form is interactive making it much easier to complete and search for required information. Once completed, the new form may be saved for future reference. However, at this time, the new form must be submitted by mail with an original signature.

Please note: at this time, a few facilities who fall into multiple program areas will have to re-submit this same form throughout the year as future registration due dates for those various program areas arise.

Rule 62-730.150 of the Florida Administrative Code makes it your responsibility to notify DEP when your facility status changes. Changes in status include, but are not limited to, changes in the facility name, location, mailing address, business form, ownership or management control of the facility or its operations; ownership of the real property (land) where the facility is located; facility contact person; type or amount of regulated waste activity; going out of business; tax default; or petition for bankruptcy protection. If your facility recently notified DEP utilizing the previous version of the 8700-12FL Florida Notification of Regulated Waste Activity form and there has been no status change whatsoever since then, you are not required to re-notify at this time utilizing the new form. However, if your facility status has changed and, therefore, needs to be updated, submit by mail the new 8700-12FL form (instructions are also on our website) with an original signature on page 4. Please make sure to include MS 4560 in our address so it will be directed to the appropriate personnel.
