ONLINE REGISTRATION NOW AVAILABLE

The Department is now accepting electronic submission of registration applications and annual reports. To access the portal for electronic submission, please go to <http://www.fldepportal.com/go>

To receive your Waste Tire Collector Registration you will need to complete a Waste Tire Collector Registration Application (Form 62-701.900(18)). Please print and read the Waste Tire Rule (62-711 and 62-701), so you will know your requirements and responsibilities as a Waste Tire Collector. The forms and the Rule are on the Florida Department of Environmental Protection website: www.dep.state.fl.us/waste/categories/tires

Please complete all the information requested for your company and your vehicles. Please include a readable copy of your CURRENT motor vehicle registration for each vehicle you wish to register. Waste Tire Collector Registrations will expire on April 1st of each year.

Please read all the information required for the Waste Tire Collector Annual Report. This will let you know what information, and records you need to maintain. Your application for renewal decals next year will not be processed until a completed annual report is received by this office. **An Annual Report must be filled in and returned next year even if you do not wish to renew.**

Please sign and date your application and send it in with your vehicle registration(s) and fee(s) all together to the following address:

We will send your new decals to you if we receive:

1. Your completed and signed Waste Tire Collector Registration Application,
 2. The fee of \$35.00 per vehicle registered,
 3. Current vehicle registrations for the vehicles you wish decals for, AND
 4. The Federal Employer Identification number (FEID) of Collector.
- If you do not have an FEID number, please submit a copy of your driver's license.

Please note that you are responsible for verifying all information, which is shared with a variety of agencies, including law enforcement officials.
