We are sending your preprinted Waste Tire Collector Registration Application, and Waste Tire Collector Annual Report, for your convenience. Waste Tire Collector Registration Renewals and Annual Reports are due by **March 1, 2012.**

Please verify and correct the information on your Waste Tire Collector Registration Application that we have on file for your company and your vehicles. Please include a readable copy of your CURRENT motor vehicle registration for each vehicle you wish to register. You may correct any information on the enclosed forms, except the "WACS ID#". If the information we have filled in on the application needs to be changed, please cross through it and write in the correct information. Please fill in **all the blanks** on the Waste Tire Collector Registration Application and Annual Report forms. Please include used tires in waste tire quantity on the Waste Tire Collector Annual Report.

Please sign both forms and send your annual report, registration renewal (with additional sheets as necessary), vehicle registrations, and fees all together to the following address by **March 1, 2012:**

We will send your new decals before the old ones expire, **if, by March 1st, we receive:**

1. Your completed and signed Waste Tire Collector Registration Application,
 2. Your completed and signed Annual Report,
 3. The fee of \$35.00 per vehicle registered,
 4. Current vehicle registrations for the vehicles you wish decals for, AND
 5. The Federal Employer Identification number (FEID) of Collector.
- If you do not have an FEID number, please submit a copy of your driver's license.

Please note that you are responsible for verifying all information, which is shared with a variety of agencies, including law enforcement officials.
