



Department of Environmental Protection Division of Waste Management Drycleaning Solvent Cleanup Program 2012 UPDATE

Registration Requirement

Drycleaning facilities are required to display the original or a copy of a valid and current registration certificate evidencing registration with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Division of Waste Management. The facility shall display this certificate in the vicinity of its drycleaning machines, and the owner or operator should ensure that the certificate is easily visible to persons making drycleaning solvent deliveries.

A person may not sell or transfer any drycleaning solvents to an owner or operator of a drycleaning facility unless the owner or operator of the drycleaning facility displays the certificate of registration issued by the department [See Section 376.303(1)(d)3., F.S.]. Facilities that fail to properly display this certificate, and any person who sells or transfers drycleaning solvents to such a facility, will be subject to penalties pursuant to Section 376.302, F.S.

Annual Registration Fee:

The annual registration renewal fee of \$100 is due for each drycleaning facility and / or wholesale supply facility in operation. The department will send out an invoice along with a return envelope for payment of the annual registration renewal prior to December. The facility shall make payment to the department within 30 days of receipt of the invoice. Facilities that fail to pay the registration fee within 30 days after receipt of the invoice are subject to a \$75 late fee.

Registered drycleaners will be mailed the certificate of registration following receipt of the annual registration fee. The certificate of registration will be necessary to purchase drycleaning solvents.

Initial Registration Fee:

New business owners and new facilities are required to submit an initial registration form and pay an initial registration fee of \$100. Once the department receives the Registration Form, an invoice for the initial \$100 registration fee will be mailed to the facility owner.

The certificate of registration for new business owner or facility will be sent following receipt of the initial registration fee. The certificate of registration will be necessary to purchase drycleaning solvents.

Unregistered facilities and facilities that have not paid prior year (s) registration fees:

Drycleaning and wholesale supply facilities will be required to pay all fees (annual, initial, and late fees) owed prior to receiving the certificate of registration.

Changes to registration:

Facilities are required to notify the department of any changes in registration by submitting a revised Registration Form or by updating the information on their annual invoice.
