## Drycleaning Solvent Cleanup Program 2017 UPDATE

### Registration Requirement

Drycleaning facilities are required to display the original or a copy of a current registration certificate evidencing registration with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Division of Waste Management. The facility shall display this certificate in the vicinity of its drycleaning machines, and the owner or operator should ensure that the certificate is easily visible to persons making drycleaning solvent deliveries.

A person may not sell or transfer any drycleaning solvents to an owner or operator of a drycleaning facility unless the owner or operator of the drycleaning facility displays the certificate of registration issued by the department [See Section 376.303(1)(d)3., F.S.]. Facilities that fail to properly display this certificate, and any person who sells or transfers drycleaning solvents to such a facility, will be subject to penalties pursuant to Section 376.302, F.S.

#### Annual Registration Fee:

The annual registration renewal fee of \$100 is due for each drycleaning facility and / or wholesale supply facility in operation. Uniform rental companies, linen supply companies, and dry-drop off facilities are not required to register. The department will send out an invoice along with a return envelope for payment of the annual registration renewal prior to December. The facility shall make payment to the department within 30 days of receipt of the invoice.

Registered drycleaners will be mailed the certificate of registration following payment.

Facilities that fail to pay the registration fee within 30 days after receipt of the invoice are subject to a **\$75** late fee.

#### Initial Registration Fee:

New facilities are required to submit an initial registration form and pay an initial registration fee of \$100. Once the department receives the Registration Form, an invoice for the initial \$100 registration fee will be mailed to the facility owner. The certificate of registration for new facilities will be sent following payment of the initial registration fee.

#### Unregistered facilities and facilities that have not paid prior year(s) registration fees:

Drycleaning and wholesale supply facilities will be required to pay all fees (initial, annual, and late fees) owed prior to receiving the certificate of registration.

#### Changes to registration / notification of closure:

Notify the department of any changes in registration including a change in ownership or a facility closing, by submitting a revised Registration Form or updating the information on your annual invoice. No fee is associated with revising a current registration or closing a current registration account.
