MESSAGE WITH RESPECT TO THE DEP BUSINESS PORTAL

The Department is utilizing an electronic permitting portal through which a variety of DEP permit authorizations and permit fee payments can be made. This system is called the DEP Business Portal and is available at: <http://www.fldepportal.com/go/>.

Please register as a user on the DEP Business Portal to begin obtaining coverage electronically under the NPDES stormwater generic permits.

Your one-time registration allows you to electronically complete, all permit-related actions online through DEP within the Business Portal. To register, please go to the web site <http://www.fldepportal.com/go/> and click on “Register” in the upper right-hand side of the web page and complete the required information.

First time users will also need to apply for a PIN:

From the “Welcome” screen please select the “Submit icon”, and then the “PIN Application”. Follow the instructions to submit the original, notarized Electronic Subscriber Agreement form by mail to the Department. Once approved you will receive an email containing your PIN. Please use your PIN to certify your Notice of Intent.

Why should you register and submit your notices online instead of through the mail?

- Ability to pay with your credit or debit cards.
- Ability to save money and time. No more postage stamps or driving to the post office.
- Ability to start and stop your application. The Business Portal will save your information at your last entry.
- Ability to select required information using drop down boxes.
- Ability to plot your facility or project location to determine your receiving water body.
- Ability to receive a copy of your permit and acknowledgment letter electronically.
- In addition, the system has extensive user support and assistance (Help tabs) built in that will, in many cases, guide you to the correct response.

We want to thank all permittees that have been using the DEP Business Portal since it saves time, money, and paper for both the applicant and our program.
